



FAQ & Guidelines

Who is eligible?

Any public or private school (PreK-12) located in Flint Energies' service territory is eligible to apply for a Full S.T.E.A.M. Ahead grant.

Does my project qualify?

To be considered for the Full S.T.E.A.M. Ahead grant, the proposed project must benefit at least 60 percent of the school's student population and concentrate in one or more of the following subjects: science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics.

Can schools submit more than one application?

Yes, each school can submit up to three entries per year.

What is the grant amount?

The grant amount is \$3,000.

What qualities is Flint looking for in the grant applications?

- Innovative, creative learning experiences for all students within your school
- Clearly defined plan of implementation
- Benefits and directly involves students
- Provides an adequate budget summary
- Provides longevity; it is not a one-time event

Who judges the applications?

A panel of judges will review the applications and rank them based on their innovative and educational plans in the areas of science, technology, engineering, arts and/or mathematics to benefit students, and the school, as a whole.

Note: This must be a blind application. DO NOT include the COUNTY, SCHOOL, TEACHER NAMES or SCHOOL MASCOTS in parts 2, 3 or 4. If you do, your application will be disqualified.

You must use the 2022 Flint Energies Full S.T.E.A.M. Ahead Grant Application form.

DO NOT attach any supplementary materials other than what is asked for.

Applicants must adhere to the word limits specified.

Grants will be awarded to schools instructing students in grades PreK-12 in Bibb, Chattahoochee, Crawford, Dooly, Harris, Houston, Macon, Marion, Monroe, Muscogee, Peach, Schley, Sumter, Talbot, Taylor, Twiggs and Upson counties.

Grants are NOT for professional development, subscription services such as Tinker Crate, Smart Boards, etc.

Applicants agree that their name, photo and project may be used in print, broadcast and other forms of media in publications of Flint Energies and the Flint Energies Foundation.

All applications must be postmarked or delivered no later than **Friday, March 4, 2022.**
